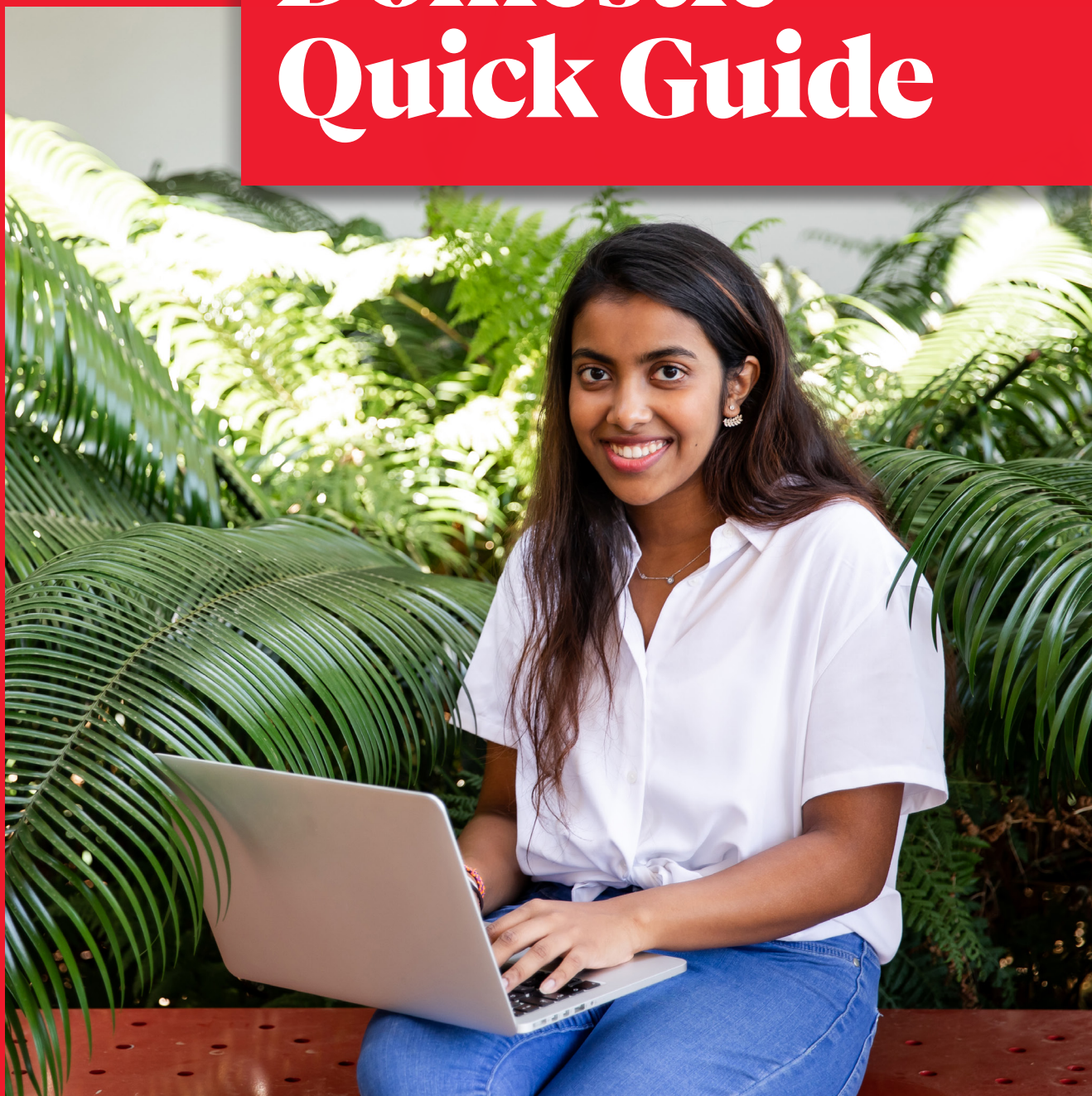

With diplomas designed to unlock university and nurture your study skills, Griffith College is your head start to success.

We have **11 exciting diploma programs** which help you jump into over 60 bachelor degrees at Griffith University. You'll find across the next pages, a list of the Griffith College programs and the associated degrees they enable you to transition to at Griffith University.

You can apply for your Griffith University degree at the same time as your Griffith College diploma, so you receive a single, combined offer. When you graduate with a Griffith College diploma, you will have your credit entitlement automatically transferred to your chosen degree at Griffith University.

Understanding the difference between VET / TAFE and a Griffith College diploma

TAFE and other private providers teach certificates through to diplomas under the Vocational Education and Training (VET) framework. They are designed to provide practical skills for employment.

Griffith College offers higher education or undergraduate diplomas that mirror the first year of a bachelor's degree. During your college year, you will learn how to research, study and write at a university level. Your end rank will be higher with us than with a VET qualification.

Year 12 graduates are admitted regardless of their ATAR results and their ATAR eligibility.

PROGRAM PROGRESSIONS

Our diplomas are equivalent to 80 credit points (CP), which in most cases is equivalent to a full year credit towards your degree. In other words, you could have direct access to the 2nd year of a bachelor degree at Griffith University, after just one year with us. To complete a three-year Griffith University degree, you need to earn a total of 240 CP.
